



This year the Central Tablelands region of the Black & Coloured Sheep Breeders Association has the privilege of organising the Wool and Natural Fibre Muster again, which will be held in the Mudgee PCYC Hall in Market St on Saturday, the 9th of June 2012, 9am to 5pm.

You are probably aware that the Muster provides crafts people with an annual opportunity to get together, share ideas, demonstrate and exchange some skills as well as participate in a friendly competition with others. The competition this time around will be “The Running of the Scarves” with a theme: “Over the Western e**SCARF**ment”. We are inviting members of all craft groups known to us as well as widely publicising the event to members of the public. We are anticipating a fun day with workshops, demonstrations, displays, and stall holders selling all types of goods involving natural fibres.

We feel that your participation would provide an added attraction to this year’s muster.

The cost of a site (appr. 3m front x 2.5m deep) is \$25, which includes an 8’ x 3’ trestle table. We will try to limit the number of sites per stall holder to 2 or 3 maximum to ensure a good variety. Set up can start after 5:30pm on Friday. The hall is secured overnight.
